Dwight B. made a motion Bill W. seconded that we get a cable for the Flag pole this year to replace the rope that was lost, motion carried.

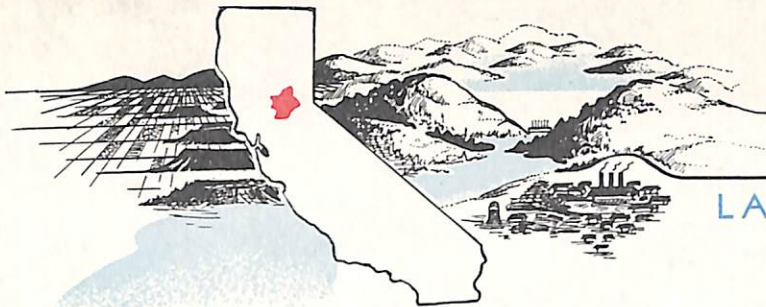
John K. was put in charge of this job.
