She died Wednesday at her home in Durham.

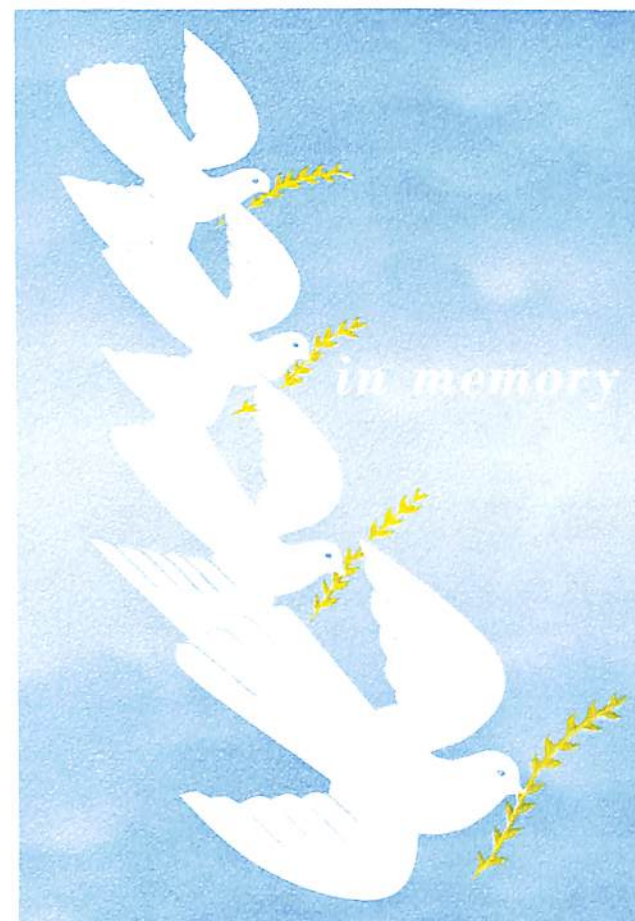
Mrs. Duncan was born June 10, 1914, in Bakersfield. She married Holmer Duncan on June 8, 1943, in Bakersfield.
